Testing:

Until at least **February 11**, 2022 – testing will be available at Queen Street (4th Floor) from Monday to Friday 8:30 am to 7:30 pm, and Saturday 10:30 am to 5 pm

Vaccination policy:

As of **February 1**, 2022, all employees must be fully vaccinated (2 doses).

Quarantine / self-isolation procedures:

Starting in January 2022, we will be following these provincial guidelines:

Ontario

Scenarios requiring self-isolation	Minimum duration	
	Fully vaccinated	Not fully vaccinated
You are experiencing symptoms or have tested positive for COVID-19	5 days	10 days
Someone in your household is experiencing symptoms or has tested positive for COVID-19	5 days	10 days
You've been in close contact with another team member at work who is experiencing symptoms or has tested positive for COVID-19	5 days	10 days
You've been in close contact with someone outside of your household or workplace who is experiencing symptoms or has tested positive for COVID-19	None	10 days

Masking:

Starting **January 19**, 2022, everyone must wear a disposable medical-grade mask (procedural or surgical mask) at all times when present in these Bell Media workplaces, including while sitting at your desk. A formal request was submitted requesting individually wrapped masks. If not possible, a request for masks to be given to employees with tongs, so that employees do not grab the masks themselves from the provided box, for sanitary reasons.
